The Town Council Monthly Meeting was called to order by Richard Craig, president.

Minutes from the May 2014 meeting approved.

Resident from 105 E Main presented pictures of property at 103 E Main, complaints of yard overgrown. Town has sent rented letter to mow but will need to send property owner now a letter.

Kevin Barnes, representing the Lewisville Franklin Township Volunteer Fire Department, spoke to the board.

He notified the board that on May 13, 2014 damage to one of the overhead doors at the fire station was done when Todd Jones drove the truck with one of the doors opened. The truck has been repaired and the department wanted permission to use the depreciation fund to repair the door. After discussion, the board asks David rich, town maintenance man, to check on fixing the door. Barnes notified the board that Randy Mercer had moved out of Town but will stay on as Fire Chief till the end of this year. Barnes also reported that the department has 11 active members. Barnes also reported that Spiceland Township and Franklin Township are in talks about possibly a fire territory.

Maintenance report given by David Rich. David was called out for electric fire on pole on south first at 1:30 on morning of June 10, 2014. This was due to limbs on wires causing town to have to remove quite a bit of tree limbs on south side of south first past the underpass. It took till 10:00 am to finish repair. Town has received new stop signs to be put up. Reported that there is another sink hole on E US 40, 701 E, IDOT has been notified.
