

**Town of Lewisville
June 9, 2015
Town Council Minutes
Houston Brick 5:00 PM**

The Town Council meeting was called to order by Richard Craig.

Board approved minutes from previous meeting.

Adam Thompson from the Lewisville Masonic Lodge presented the written contract for the Lewisville Shelter House for the board to sign.

Board addressed questions from the audience, electric rates for residential and commercial, questions concerning Henry County Planning Commission, fire department station responsible for lighting replacement (fire department is responsible for all inside maintenance, David Rich (town maintenance has rebuilt 4 of the lights in bay), and pot hole on Market Street, (David checked this out before and did not find source). Mr. Charles Covey stated he did not like form letters without a signature (he had received an ordinance violation letter).

Water adjustments for leaks were discussed. Board has not set the policy for water adjustments due to leaks.

Patty Morton stated that a policy needs to be set before any adjustments are to be made. Board tabled adjustments till policy set. Clerk to research information for policy.

The Town Board is to set pay for the Town Election Board for the municipal elections which will be held this year. Chairmen from each political party have appointed their representative to the board. Democrat is Tricia Haler and Republican Kathy Bowling. Board set pay as \$100 for service on Town Election Board. The Clerk Treasurer sets on the Board as secretary but does not receive any extra pay.

David Rich gave maintenance report. Power outage today on Helen Blvd. Limb fell on line. Took about 4 hours to repair. Lighting must have struck burn pile in park night of June 8, causing it to burn. David explained the Lewisville Water Utility 2014 Consumer Confidence Report the utility has to submit every year. The water hydrants will be flushed 3 times a year, previously only flushed 2 times a year. Will have to do quarterly test for Haloacetic Acids (HAA5)*, Total Trihalomethanes (TTHM).

Bucket truck power steering was repaired by David. Mowers have been serviced. These mowers are expected to be in service at least 10 years. David researched these mowers especially having to mow when wet. David has replaced one of the toilets in the shelter house. Pot holes were discussed, waiting on material Todd Jones stated we would be getting from State. Drains were discussed. David stated that a vac would be needed to unplug drains. Board stated that residents are not to put yard waste in the street. Board wants abandoned vehicles to be tagged. Clerk will call sheriff's department to come and tag vehicles.

Claims approved as presented.

With no other business to be brought before the board, Meeting adjourned.
